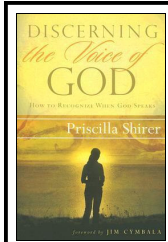


Fall Festival Saturday, November 5th

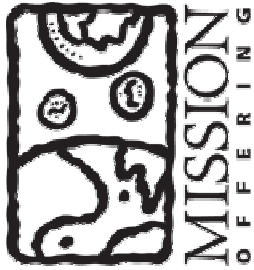

WORLD MISSIONS DAY/JUBILEE BIRTHDAY OFFERING

We will have Sheila Osborne—Coordinator of Short-Term Ministry and Liaison to Women's Ministry for World Witness speaking in the Worship Service Sunday, November 20th. Shelia and her husband, Jeff, were commissioned as missionaries with World Witness in 2001. After completion of pre-field training and language school, they moved to San Luis Potosi, Mexico in 2002. After living in San Luis Potosi for one and half years, Jeff and Shelia moved to Rio Verde. Their ministry together in Mexico included discipleship courses with adult couples, training children's workers, Bible Clubs and hosting Short-Term Mission Groups. In addition, Shelia established and managed a Lending Library of Christian Education materials for local churches, taught Sunday School, led a women's Bible Study, and taught English.

In March, 2009, they returned to the United States for Jeff to seek medical care for some health issues he developed. The Osbornes are members of Covenant ARP Church in Statesville, NC, where Jeff serves as an elder. Before their service in Mexico, they were active in their church, as well as with the Christian Motorcyclists Association.

They adopted their daughter, Sarahi in Mexico.

The Jubilee Birthday celebration is a time each year that an offering is taken throughout Synod. There are two missionaries whose sole support is provided by this offering sponsored by the ARP Women's Ministry. The current missionaries are Judy Buis and Nanette Howard.

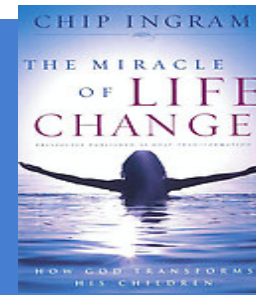
For several years Crowders Creek ladies have opened this opportunity up to everyone when our church celebrates church-wide Missions Sunday.
