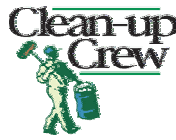

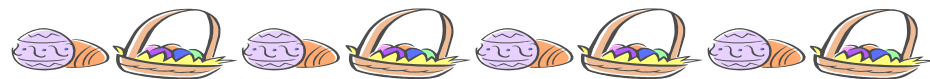
Quest Jr. High Conference
